



PUBLIC NOTICE

PROPOSED LEAKING UST (LUST) CASE CLOSURE

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is considering closure of the following leaking underground storage tank (LUST) case:

LUST No. 3943.01
Facility ID No. 0-001044
Gila County

Former Chevron Service Station No. 9-7915

Globe, AZ 85501

The Arizona Revised Statutes 49-1005(E) and Arizona Administrative Code [A.A.C.] R18-12-263.04 allow case closure of LUST sites with groundwater contamination above the Arizona Aquifer Water Quality Standards (AWQS) after eligibility requirements are met. For the above-referenced LUST site, ADEQ has considered the following criteria:

1. Whether the UST release has been adequately investigated
2. Whether the source of contamination that affected groundwater quality has been removed
3. Whether the soil meets the applicable soil remediation levels
4. Whether there are drinking water wells that are threatened or impacted by the UST release
5. Whether the groundwater plume is not expanding
6. Whether the groundwater contamination is naturally attenuating
7. Whether the requirements of A.R.S. §49-1005(D) and (E) have been met

The plume of release-related compounds was reduced by Chemical Treatment and Natural Attenuation until only wells MW-1 and MW-5 had concentrations of benzene exceeding the AWQS.

If sufficient public interest is demonstrated during the public comment period, ADEQ will announce and hold a public meeting. ADEQ will respond to comments in writing following the public comment period.
