**ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY
NOTICE OF THE AVAILABILITY OF THE RECORD OF DECISION FOR THE
TYSON WASH WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF)
REGISTRY SITE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has issued a record of decision (ROD) which is deemed a final administrative decision as defined by A.R.S. §41-1092 for the Tyson Wash WQARF Site in Quartzsite, Arizona. The ROD contains a description of the remedy, a time for completing the remedy, a total estimated cost, and a time-frame for review. No comments were received on the proposed remedial action plan (PRAP), so a responsiveness summary is not included in the ROD.

The Tyson Wash WQARF Site contaminated groundwater plume is bounded approximately by W. Sunset Street to the north, Oregon Avenue to the west, Main Street (Business I-10) to the south, and N. Central Boulevard (SR-95) to the east. The known groundwater contamination exists northwest of the intersection of State Hwy 95 and Business route I-10 in the Town of Quartzsite, Arizona.

The Tyson Wash WQARF Site was placed on the WQARF Registry in 1998 with a score of 46 out of a possible 120 points. The scoring of a site, its relative score, or its placement on the Registry does not necessarily represent a determination that the release of a hazardous substance from the site poses a threat to human health or welfare of the environment.

The final community advisory board meeting will be held providing a presentation on the ROD for the Tyson Wash WQARF Site on Wednesday, August 12, 2009 at 1:00 p.m. at the Public Library, 465 N.
