YOU HAVE A VOICE IN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL IN ARIZONA

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has reached a preliminary determination and is proposing to issue Air Quality Control Permit Numbers 48685, 49155, 49442 and 49650 to CEMEX Construction Materials South, LLC for concrete batch plants. The plants are located at the following locations:

- 1950 Bullhead Parkway in Bullhead City, Mohave County for Permit No. 48685 the mailing address for this facility is 7150 Pollock Drive, Las Vegas, Nevada 89119
- 91 West Old Ruby Road, Nogales, Santa Cruz County for Permit No. 49155
- South Highway 77 in Holbrook, Navajo County for Permit No. 49442
- 1250 N. Penrod Road, Show Low, Navajo County for Permit No. 49650

The mailing address for the remaining facilities is 4646 E. Van Buren St., Ste. 250, Phoenix, Arizona 85008. The proposed permits are subject to the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act, Arizona Revised Statute 49-426, and the Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 2, Article 3, 6, and 7. The proposed permits will limit emissions of the following types of air contaminants: particulate matter, particulate matter with an aerodynamic diameter less than 10 microns, oxides of nitrogen, carbon monoxide, sulfur dioxide and volatile organic compounds.

This public notice provides information to help you participate in the decision-making process. You have an opportunity to submit written comments on any of these permits, and request that ADEQ hold a public hearing on any of these permits. The written comment shall state the name and mailing address of this person, shall be signed by the person, their agent or attorney and shall clearly set forth reasons why the permits should or should not be issued. Grounds for comment are limited to whether the permits meet the criteria for issuance spelled out in the state air pollution control laws or rules.

Persons wishing to submit written comments or request a public hearing have until September 4, 2009, to do so. ADEQ will consider all comments received in making a final decision on the proposed permits. Everyone commenting will receive notification of the final decisions. People who file comments on a permit will have the right to appeal the final decision as an appealable agency action to the Office of Administrative Hearing (OAH) pursuant to §41.1092.03, and the appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of the final decision. The OAH may sustain, modify, or reverse the final decision.
